COPIER – COPYRIGHT POLICY

The Town of Gainesville Public Library provides photocopying service to its patrons for the copying of non-circulating materials such as reference books, magazines, newspapers, and local history materials. Fees for the copier are established by the Library Board of Trustees.

Photocopier service is available to the patron upon request of a staff member. When assisting with the copier, staff will not knowingly violate copyright law. Patrons requesting photocopier service must adhere to the U.S. Copyright Law when copying materials. The copyright law of the United States (Title 17, U.S. Code) governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material. The person obtaining copies is liable for any infringement. Further information about copyright law may be found at the U.S. Copyright Office's website: www.copyright.gov.

Any print jobs sent to the library printer from a patron at a library computer will be released to the printer. Patrons will follow the same copyright laws (U.S. Copyright Law; Title 17, U.S. Code). Patrons can collect their printed copies upon paying for the copies. Those patrons seeking high quality printing or copies are directed to use a printing business for this purpose.
